How to Review Your 2025 Assessment Notice

Use this one-page checklist to make sure your 2025 Alabama property assessment is accurate. A quick review now can help you catch mistakes and avoid overpaying taxes.

1. Check Your Notice Details

- 1 Verify your name, address, and parcel number.
- 2 Confirm the property class (Class III for owner-occupied homes).
- 3 Compare the new assessed value to last year's value.

2. Compare With Market Reality

- 1 Check recent nearby sales similar in age, size, and condition.
- 2 \(\bigveet \) If your home's value is much higher than others, make a note.
- 3 Consider if any major updates or additions could have raised value.

3. Apply the 7% Cap Rule

- 1 \(\vert \) If your assessed value rose more than 7%, confirm your home qualifies for the cap.
- 2 The cap applies to owner-occupied homes, farmland, and timberland.

4. Know Your Deadlines

- ↑ Appeals are typically due within 30 days of notice in Jefferson and Shelby Counties.
- Visit your county Board of Equalization website for current forms and instructions.

5. Stay Organized

- 1 V Keep copies of your notice, appeal forms, and supporting evidence.
- Write down all dates and confirmations for your records.
